

PRESERVE

BRC restores public access to Indian Knowledge Systems by conserving and digitizing manuscripts, creating public and digital libraries

Challenges

Fragile manuscripts, limited trained manpower, and limitations of OCR technology for regional Indian languages

Conservation

The BRC team restores manuscripts and rare books, following standards set by the National Manuscripts Mission and the National Archives of India




