about my Permanent Visa & he

I come back. Please make an
appointment with him informing
that I wish to present him a set
of Bhagavatam and our other
literatures. Then go to him and
personally present the books etc.
at Washington D.C. It may
be that I shall be coming back
very soon as soon as I feel some

no disturbance about my health
and I hope to reach Delhi
this night. I shall write you
again after reaching Vrindavan.
Convey my ardent affection
and blessings for all the
boys & girls. I am very much
hopeful for my movement. Please
keep steady, follow all my last

Hare Krishna and Krishna
will give you all strength. Hope
you are all doing well. I am
